HB 17-1011 to establish a 7 year Statute of Limitations for DORA complaints against mental health professionals passed the Senate Health and Human Services Committee at 3:30pm yesterday with a unanimous 5-0 vote. Committee members said they heard your voice in the calls and emails to them. This was Step 3 of 5. Now the full Colorado Senate must vote on our bill.

Please continue to encourage your friends, family members, and especially your fellow registered psychotherapists to call and email their **own Colorado State Senator** and ask for a "yes" vote on HB17-1011. **Both a call and an email are even better for the result we want!**

This is our **BEST** chance to get protections for us passed into law so we can build our practices in a safer business environment. This is long overdue. We are almost there.
